1: The ratio of children to adults is 5:3

24 adults in a group of 64 people 15 children in a group of 24 people 40 people are there altogether



## 2: The ratio of brown eyes to blue eyes is 15:1

90 people with brown eyes if there are 96 people 3 people with blue eyes in a group of 48 people 105 people with brown eyes

## 3: The ratio of lions to monkeys in a zoo is 1:4

28 monkeys if there are 7 lions
9 lions if there are 45 lions and monkeys altogether
There are 75 lions and monkeys altogether if there are 60 monkeys

## 4: The ratio of pencils to rulers to rubbers is 4:2:1

8 rubbers if there are 32 pencils 40 pencils if there are 20 rulers 28 pencils, 14 rulers and 7 rubbers
